COLLEGE LIBRARY

SIR SYED CENTRAL LIBRARY,

The Sir Syed Central Library, Govt. Degree College for Women, Baramulla is functioning as an important Information and Knowledge resource center in the college. The College Library houses approx 34,000 books including 7,000 reference Books.

The college Library is fully automated using SOUL 3.0 ILMS and is being upgraded with Issue/Return facility and Anti theft RFID based technology. The Library is also enriched with online catalogue facility in the form of OPAC. (Online Public Access Catalogue).

The other facilities available in the Library is Book Bank, Question Bank, Reprography, Reading Room, Browsing Center, New Arrivals display, Facilitation cum Utility centre and OPAC facility.

The Library also subscribes access to more than 6,000 e-journals and 1, 60,000 e-Books through NLISTdatabase.



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The college is providing financial aid to orphans, the physically challenged, and students from humble and marginalized backgrounds.

Further the Scholarship section of the collage act as facilitation centre for various government sponsored scholarships like, PMSSS, NSP, Pahari Speaking Students Scholarship etc.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

We cultivate cultural activities which encompass in a wide range of events, programs, and experiences to celebrate and promote the art, heritage, traditions, exhibitions, festivals, cuisine and more among students keeping in mind their holistic developments, interests and talents.



NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC)

The college has a vibrant NCC Unit which focuses in character development of the students by instigating discipline, leadership, comradeship, adventurous spirit and altruist principles.



INFRASTRUCTURAL DEVELOPMENT

- Construction of Phase-II of the Science Block: The Department of Higher Education approved an amount of one Crore under CAPEX Budget 2023-24 for the ongoing work on construction of Phase-II of the Science Block. It is pertinent to mention that Phase-II of the Science Block is being constructed at an estimated cost of rupees 1471.72 lakhs.
- **2.** Renovation of Home Science Block: Home Science Block of the College has been renovated. The renovated Block with all facilities is now available for the students.
- Infrastructure Development for introduction of Skill Courses: Computer Science and Commerce labs are getting renovated and upgraded so that skill courses under NEP-2202 will be offered to the students.
- **4.** Up-gradation of Drinking water facility: The College Administration installed five new water purifiers at different places to upgrade drinking water facility for students and faculty in the campus.
- 5. Up-gradation of Boutique Technology Center and establishment History Museum: The College has renovated the Boutique Technology Center to accommodate more trainees in Cutting/tailoring, Till-work and Sozni work courses. Moreover, History Museum is being established in the Admission Block of the College.
- 6. Establishment of Girls Common Room and Day Care Room: The College Administration established a Girls Common Room in AD-Block and Daycare room in the Music Block.

BOUTIQUE TECHNOLOGY CENTRE

Boutique/Fashion Technology Centre offers students to explore the creative realms of present contemporary fashion with holistic learning. The Centre is well-equipped with state of art machines and equipments and has an accomplished team of 2(two) tailor masters who provide

skills in tailoring and embroidery. Currently the Centre is offering Three months certificate course in cutting, tailoring, Tilla work, crewel and Sozni and about 30 students are enrolled .Besides the students of college all the females from the vicinity are also eligible for taking up the course under Community extension activities. The program aims to provide opportunity to those who wish to develop new skills for becoming self-reliant.

BROWSING CENTRE

The Library has a Big Browsing centre with LAN and Internet facility. The students utilise the facility during their free hours. They search, download reading material, make their assignments and use the various e- resources which are



subscribed by the Library. Students are also encouraged to use Open Educational Resources which are freely available on the Internet like Swayam, e-PG Pathshala, e-Content Courseware in UG Subject's etc. The links of these resources has also been kept available on the College Library website for easy access.



COLLEGE TRANSPORT FACILITY:

At Present College has one functional bus available and the same is utilized for transportation and ferrying students to attend Tours\various programmers in different institutions of the Valley.

5. Well Maintained Badminton court:


